RE: KEY FINDINGS FROM A SURVEY OF LIKELY REPUBLICAN PRIMARY VOTERS IN THE FIRST CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

The Tarrance Group is pleased to present the Congressional Leadership Fund with the key findings from a survey of voter attitudes in the First Congressional District of New Hampshire. These key findings are based on telephone interviews with N=302 "likely" Republican primary voters throughout the district. Responses to this survey were gathered August 1-4, 2022 and the margin of error associated with a sample of this type is  $\pm$  5.8% in 95 out of 100 cases.

## **KEY FINDINGS**

Matt Mowers holds a commanding lead in the primary for NH-01, polling 24 points ahead of the field. Notably, Mowers leads by 15 points with Trump Republicans and leads by 21 points with self-identified "very conservative" voters. Mowers is also better-known and better-liked than anyone else in the field, nearly doubling the favorable ratings of his challengers.
